**VINTAGE:** 2011

**REGION:** Veneto

**GRAPES:** Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara

**ALCOHOL:** 14.5% vol.

**WINE CHARACTERISTICS:** Dark ruby/purple color. A long lasting nose with silky, sexy texture. Secoli Amarone is an intensely flavored dry red wine made from dried (passito) grapes. It is made in the Veneto region of north-eastern Italy, and is arguably the region's most prestigious red wine.

**PAIRS WITH:** Red meats, game and rich cheeses. It is also a perfect after-dinner wine. For best results, open the wine 30 minutes before drinking so as to allow it to breathe.

**AGEING:** 3 years oak casks

**SERVING TEMPERATURE:** 68 °F (22 °C)

**PACKAGING:** 12 bottles ML750

**TASTING NOTES:** Long, dry finish of chocolate and dried cherries. A tremendous opportunity for a wine style not usually discounted because of the production. Aromas of tar, ripe cherry, raspberry, cocoa and dried fruit. The palate is rich and saturating with chocolate, cherry, cinnamon and cocoa. Finishes very long and silky.
