

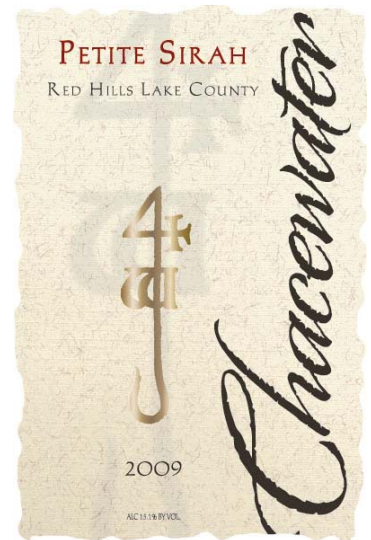

Varietals: 94% Petite Sirah, 4% Petit Verdot

This site specific Vineyard produces fruit that gives this wine extremely intense smoky richness with pepper spice. The ripe fruit makes a massive showing and a strong finish.



Tasting Notes

This wine gives a generous offering of smoky richness with pepper spice. Intense mineral coupled with ripe fruit makes for massive wine showing restraint and elegance deep into its complex finish.

McDermaid Family Vineyards:

In 1996 the McDermaid Family purchased a tired old walnut ranch in what was to become the Red Hills - Lake County Appellation in Kelseyville, California.

For the next four years working on week-ends, holidays and spare time the trees were removed and Malbec, Petite Sirah, and Petite Verdot were planted. They were generous enough to share their Malbec lot with Chacewater Winery to produce a spectacular wine.
