



Guy Chaumont Bourgogne Pinot Noir

AOC Côte Chalonnaise

100% Pinot Noir

12.5% Alcohol

Aging: Mostly in old oak, 1/10 in new oak, and some in older oak foudre

Cellar: up to 5 years

Guy Chaumont produces red, white, and sparkling wines from vineyards on the Cote Chalonnaise, a low ridge extending south of Beaune in the center of France's famous Burgundy region. The Chaumont vineyards have been farmed organically since 1965 and are certified by Ecocert. His wines are unfiltered for maximum flavor and contain only small amounts of added sulfites.

This Pinot Noir is aged in mostly old oak barrels after pressing. It is smooth, fruity and aromatic, full of the ripe berry flavor of Pinot Noir with an earthy, slightly smoky finish. It will age gracefully and is excellent with roast chicken, grilled salmon, beef and pork dishes, and cheeses.
